

Carpenters Star at 250 Clark/FibreChick - Feb. 27, March 26, April 23 & May 28, 2020

PLEASE NOTE: This class will involve monthly "sewing at home" work.

Equipment, Tools and Supplies - Home

For this project you will need the following – at your home sewing space - to successfully complete a Lone Star Quilt top.

- Sewing Machine in good working order
- ¼" foot or a marking that will meet your needs
- Rotary cutting mat – 18" x 24" or larger
- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- 6" x 24" acrylic ruler with 45 degree markings
- 50 weight cotton sewing thread – neutral colour or to match fabrics
- 10/70 or 12/80 sewing machine needles – sharp or quilting
- Pins/pincushion full of pins
- Mini Clips
- Seam Ripper
- Stilletto/bamboo skewer
- iron

Bring to class the following:

- Rotary cutting mat (optional)
- Rotary cutter with new/sharp blade
- 6" x 24" acrylic ruler with 45-degree markings
- Fabric
- Pins
- Mini Clips or clothespins
- Iron (optional)
- Ironing pad (optional)

Carpenters Star Fabric Selection – Colour contrast makes this quilt!

Please note, these are only approximate amounts for the Star.

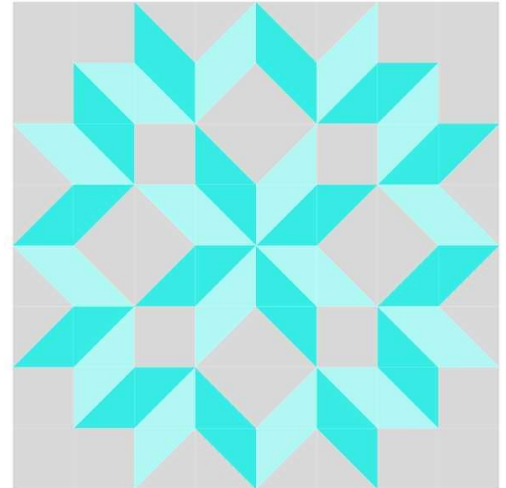
This quilt can be modified with borders to make a rectangular quilt.

Three Colour: 108" x 108" (Double Star)

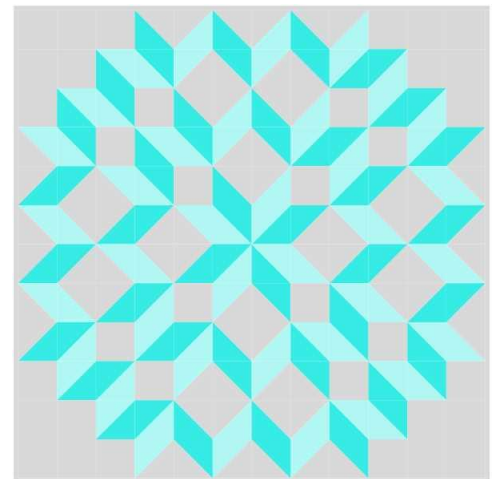
- **Background:** 4 m. – 5 m.
- **Focus Fabrics:** 2.5 m. – based on two colours

Nine Colour: 108" x 108" (Double Star)

- **Background:** 4 m. – 5 m.
- **Focus Fabrics:** .25 m. - .5 m of each fabric. Extra if you intend of using Focus Fabrics in the border.
