

HAVE A HEART BASKET

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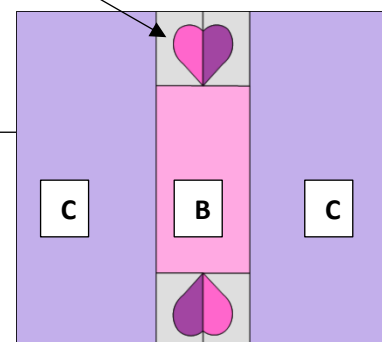
- **Right Sides Together: RST**

CONSTRUCTION

OUTER SHELL

1. **PIECE**, according to the chart, the Outer Shell to desired basket size.
2. **CENTER & SEW** or **FUSE** the stabilizer to the wrong side of the Outer Shell.
3. **DRAW** lines, according to size chart, from all four edges of the Outer Shell on the wrong side of the basal. Be sure to use the edge of the Outer Shell as your guide.
4. **SEW** on the drawn lines. A walking foot makes this easier.
Sewing on the drawn lines will give the stabilizer memory for folding the sides of the basket.
5. **CUT** rectangles on the **SHORT SIDES**, just inside the sewn lines. Refer to diagram.
6. **SEW** two **SIDE SEAMS** - ½" seams.
7. **FORM & SEW** bottom of basket. **TURN THE BASKET IS RIGHT SIDE OUT.** Set aside.

LINING

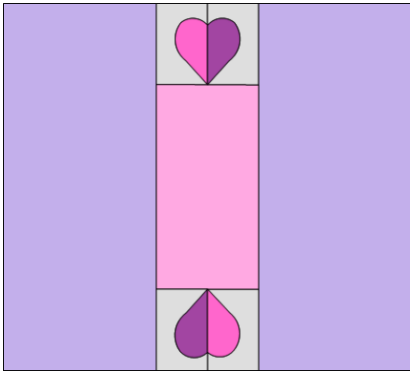
1. **DRAW** lines, according to the diagram, on the wrong side of the **LINING**. **MEASURE** from the raw edge.
2. **CUT** rectangles on the **SHORT SIDES**, between the lines. Refer to diagram.
3. **SEW** two **SIDE SEAMS** - ½" seams.
4. **"BOX"** bottom of basket lining. **Center the seam & sew the bottom. Keep in mind:**
 - First seam is sewn as usual.
 - Second seam is sewn, **PARTIALLY, BEING SURE TO LEAVE A HOLE FOR TURNING.**
5. **LEAVE THE LINING WRONG SIDE OUT.** Set aside.

ASSEMBLE YOUR BASKET

1. **PLACE** the Outer Shell inside the Lining – **RST**. **LINE UP** seams and **CLIP OR PIN** THE RAW EDGES.
2. **SEW** around the entire top of the basket.
3. **TURN OUT** the basket, by pulling the Outer Shell through the hole left in the lining seam.
4. **PRESS.**
5. **STITCH IN THE DITCH, ALONG THE BOTTOM EDGE OF THE "FAUX BINDING".**
6. **HAND STITCH**, the hole in the lining, using a matching thread.

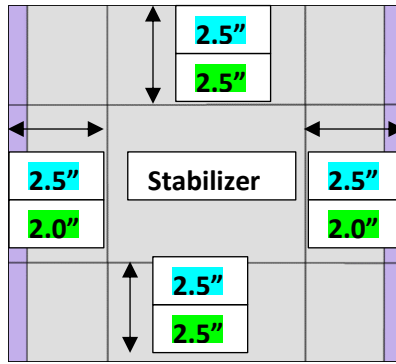
