

**OHIO STAR**  
FIBRECHICK

- Read entire pattern before sewing.
- ¼" seam allowance
- Width of Fabric: WOF
- Right Sides Together: RST
- Press in the direction of arrows.

**Construction**

Background

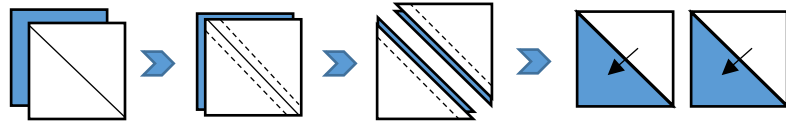
Star Focus Fabric

**Step 1:** According to the size chart below cut appropriate sized squares to construct half-square triangle blocks. Layer Background and Star Focus fabrics RST. Mark a diagonal line. Sew ¼" seam on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Open and press to the dark fabric. You will have made two half square triangle blocks.

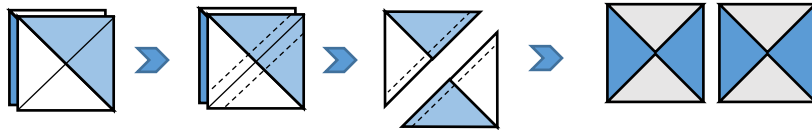
Make four blocks in total before continuing to the next step.

**Half-Square Triangles Size Chart**

3"	6"	9"	12"	24"
2 - 2 ½"	2 - 3 ½"	2 - 4 ½"	2 - 5 ½"	2 - 9 ½"
2 - 2 ½"	2 - 3 ½"	2 - 4 ½"	2 - 5 ½"	2 - 9 ½"



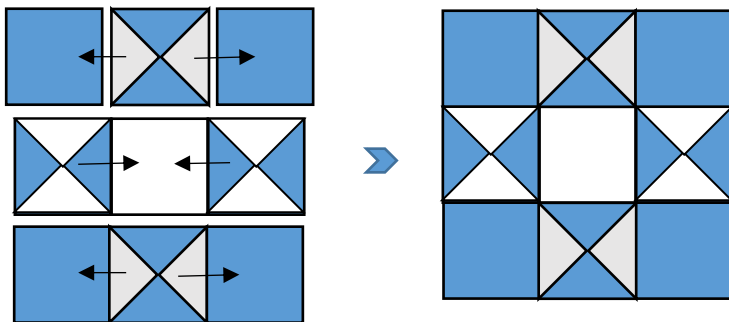
**Step 2:** To create quarter square triangle blocks, layer two half square triangle blocks RST with opposite fabrics facing each other. Nest the seams together. Draw a diagonal line, opposite to the sewn diagonal. Sew ¼" seam on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to make two quarter square triangle blocks. Make four blocks. Square up the blocks to appropriate size according to the Ohio Star Block Size Chart.



**Ohio Star Block Size Chart**

3"	6"	9"	12"	24"
4 - 1 ½"	4 - 2 ½"	4 - 3 ½"	4 - 4 ½"	4 - 8 ½"
1 - 1 ½"	1 - 2 ½"	1 - 3 ½"	1 - 4 ½"	1 - 8 ½"
4 - 1 ½"	4 - 2 ½"	4 - 3 ½"	4 - 4 ½"	4 - 8 ½"

**Step 3:** Layout and assemble Ohio Star Block.
