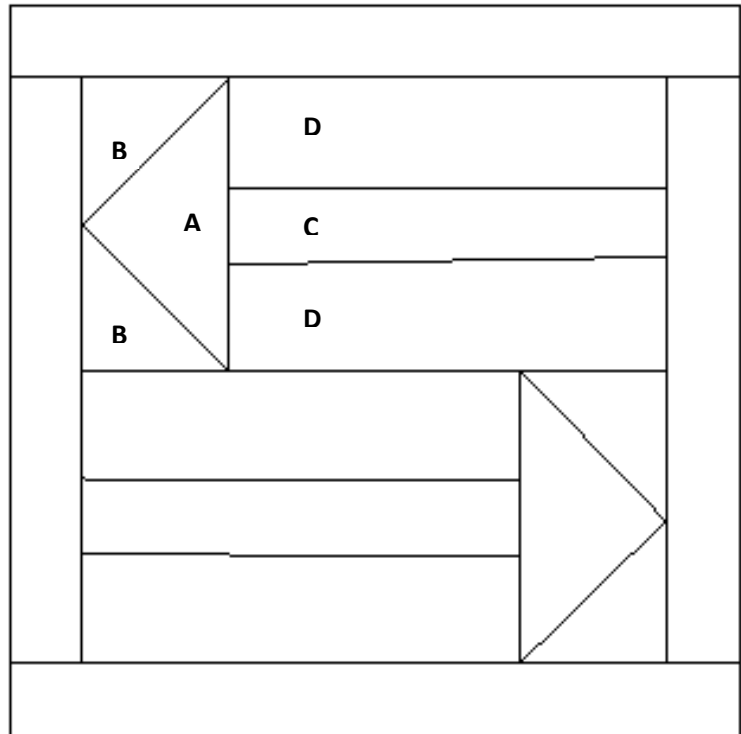


SOCIAL DISTANCING "ARROWS"
4" X 4"
FIBRECHICK

		CUT
ARROWS	A	2 - 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"
	C	2 - 1" x 7"
BACKGROUND	B	4 - 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
	D	4 - 1 1/2" x 7"
BORDERS	SIDES	1 1/4" X 4 1/2"
	TOP & BOTTOM	1 1/4" X 6"

- All sewn seams are 1/4".
- Right Sides Together: RST

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BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. **SEW**, WITH RST, D+C+D MAKING BLOCK UNIT DCD.
2. **CUT** BLOCK UNIT DCD IN HALF.
 2 - 2 1/2" X 3 1/2"
3. **SEW & FLIP** – USE THIS METHOD TO CREATE THE FLYING GEESE BLOCKS, "ARROW HEADS", 2 - 1 1/2" X 2 1/2".
4. **SEW** BLOCK UNIT BAB TO BLOCK UNIT DCD. MAKE 2 - 2 1/2" X 4 1/2 "ARROWS".
5. **SEW** THE ARROWS, WITH THE "ARROW HEADS", FACING IN OPPOSITE DIRECTIONS.
6. **TRIM** THE SOCIAL DISTANCE ARROWS BLOCK TO MEASURE 4 1/2" X 4 1/2".

MUG MAT - 6" X 6"

PLEASE NOTE: All borders are added by sewing first to the sides of the block; next to the top and bottom of the block.

- **LAYER** BATTING; BACKING & BLOCK RST.
- **SEW** AROUND THE OUTER EDGE LEAVING 2" TO 3" OPENING.
- **CLIP** CORNERS TO REDUCE BULK.
- **TURN** RIGHT SIDES OUT.
- **QUILT (STITCH)** IN THE DITCH ON THE INSIDE OF THE BORDER.
- **STITCH** THE OPENING SHUT.
